AFA OFFERS A SCHOLARSHIP TO A DESERVING **GRADUATE STUDENT** EACH YEAR. THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD CAN BE USED IN ANY WAY TO SUPPORT THE RECIPIENT'S GRADUATE EDUCATION. AFA ONLY ASKS THAT THE RECIPIENT PRESENT THEIR RESEARCH AT THE NEXT YEAR'S AFA MEETING.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be currently enrolled in a graduate degree program in a field related to fisheries science at an educational institution that is accredited and in Alabama.
2. Currently in good academic standing.
3. Must have a research proposal that is approved by their graduate advisor.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR SCHOLARSHIPS:

ALL OF THIS IS DUE TO THE AFA SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE BY 1 NOVEMBER

1. A copy of transcripts of undergraduate and graduate work completed to date
2. A letter from the student's major professor recommending the student for the scholarship, indicating that the student is currently enrolled and in good standing and has had their research proposal approved by their graduate advisory committee
3. A copy of the research proposal or an executive summary/abstract of the proposal
4. One letter of recommendation (from other than the major professor)
